Dear DBN Community,

The 2025 Entrepreneurship Training Programme concluded with **48 MSMEs** selected as grant winners from over **48,000 MSMEs trained** virtually nationwide. From this pool (48,000), **900 participants** advanced to the in-person workshop, where the final beneficiaries emerged.



Now in its **7th edition**, the programme recorded **52.1% female** participation, with Agriculture leading (**39.6%**) and Manufacturing attracting higher funding intensity.

Eight (8) MSMEs supported in each region

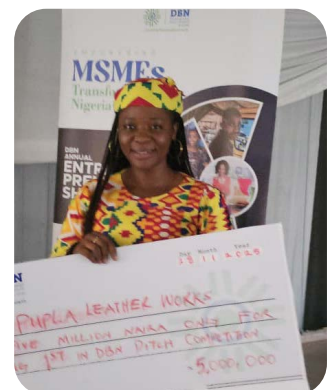


Highest grant awarded was **N5 Million in each zone**
